This fantastic concert march was written in 1907 and is regarded by many as one of Fučík finest works. The triumphant ending makes it a great finale to any concert, leaving your audience with a smile on their face and a spring in their step!

Program Notes

A Czech composer and conductor of military bands, Julius Fučík (1872–1916) is probably best known for his march “Entry of the Gladiators.” In *The Florentiner March*, Fučík condenses two fanfares, a beautiful floating melody, an interlude, and a triumphant repeat into a single march. It was originally entitled “La Rose di Toscana,” but for political reasons Fučík was forced to change his salute from the entire region of Tuscany to its capital, Florence.

Notes to the Conductor

To achieve the maximum effect in this piece, try to make measures 123–155 as tranquil and gentle as possible. Do not allow the dynamics to grow too quickly between letters 155–171, and have fun with the finale!
